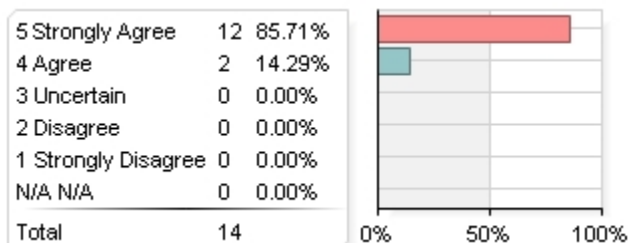

Comments
Professor Harrington is incredibly thoughtful with the material he chose for this course. It was a great mix of reflection with structure and learning valuable skills for life beyond BC.
This was a very good course because it approached the concepts both in a practical way and in a way that made you think deeply about your life and what matters most to you. I felt that it was a good mix of thinking critically as well as thinking in a very fact based, analytical way. I really enjoyed the class discussions. I laughed a lot throughout the course and feel like I learned a lot about myself. I felt very connected to the other students in the class and got to know a lot of people very well. The course also made me feel more prepared to take on the next semester as I prepare to apply for more jobs and start my post-grad life.
This course has a lot of strengths. The biggest is that Brad Harrington is such an amazing teacher and is the kind of professor that makes his students want to learn and participate in class. He is clearly emotionally invested in the class, which inspires us to take all assignments and readings seriously. Furthermore, his use of Padlet was extremely effective in getting class discussions to be participatory. The flow of this course is also very good, with every assignment helping with the next. The use of small groups to break up the large chunk of time the class took up was also great.
Prof. Harrington is incredibly knowledgeable about the intersection of life and work and is a wonderful resource to speak with. He cares deeply about his students and strives to help us discern our calling and steps for future success. I really enjoyed tackling the various components of the self-assessment, including the autobiography and the peer coaching exercise. This course created a much-needed space to discuss important topics in discernment and work-life balance.

The implications assignment was very unclear and seemed very rushed at the end of the semester, but is something that could have helped students really navigate their near future.
